The **Government of Kosovo** has received a *loan* from the *International Development Association* toward the cost of *Water Security and Canal Protection Project*, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this *loan* to payments under the contract for **Design, Supply, Installation and Commissioning of a SCADA System for the Iber Canal (IFB ref. No: WSCP-G-ICB-2)**.

The *Ibër Lepenc Company* serves as the implementing agency for the project and now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for above mentioned contract. The time for design and installation of the system is expected 48 weeks. Bidding will be conducted using the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: World Bank's: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers published in January 2011, revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all Bidders eligible as defined in these Guidelines; Bidders should also meet the following minimum qualification criteria (refer to the bidding documents for the full qualification requirements/criteria):

Financial Capacity:

- Minimum average annual turnover as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years (i.e. 2016, 2017 and 2018) of EUR 2,000,000.00 (two million euro);
- The Bidder must demonstrate access to, or availability of, financial resources such as liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means equal with EUR 330,000.00;

Past Experience:

- Participation as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least one (1) contract within the last five (5) years (i.e. 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018), with a value of at least Euro 600,000, that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed SCADA Supply and Installation Services.
